**SAENGER THEATER TO HOST BLAME THE COMIC
& FRIENDS COMEDY SHOW SEPT. 16**

HATTIESBURG (August 9, 2017) — The Historic Hattiesburg Saenger Theater is hosting Blame the Comic and Friends comedy tour on Saturday, September 16 at 7 p.m.

Blame the Comic is an Internet sensation whose popular videos include “stuff mothers say when” and other recognizable situations. His career began in 2004 with his appearance on B.E.T.’s comedy competition show “Coming to the Stage” and winning multiple national comedy contests.
