## **Five-Time Grammy Winner, Marty Stuart, Making A Stop At Duling Hall**

(JACKSON, MS, August 19, 2014) – On Friday, September 19, 2014, Marty Stuart & The Fabulous Superlatives will perform at Duling Hall. Born in Philadelphia, Mississippi, Stuart caught the music bug early. Touring by age 13 with Lester Flatt's band, and in his twenties with Johnny Cash, Bill Monroe, Jerry Lee Lewis, and Carl Perkins. Stuart was off to a good start in his music career.

Winning Grammys, having Platinum records, Stuart was "on top of the world," but he soon came to realize he did not like the way his legacy was shaping up. He vowed to get back to the music he had always loved, and took a huge risk in the record *The Pilgrim*. Johnny Cash even told him he was setting himself up for rejection, but Stuart said it was something he had to do. With that record, Stuart reconnected with his true self, a piece of himself that he had hidden away years before, to go exploring.

Not wanting to go on this new journey alone, he recruited fellow musical missionaries, and formed The Fabulous Superlatives. Stuart knew from the first rehearsal, that this was the band of the lifetime, and they have released several acclaimed albums, like *Ghost Train: The Studio B Sessions* and *Souls' Chapel*, as well as "The Marty Stuart Show," a musical variety program. This fall Marty Stuart & The Fabulous Superlatives will be touring supporting the release of *Saturday Night and Sunday Morning*, scheduled to come out late September.

We will announce this concert August 20<sup>th</sup> at 10am, and tickets will go on sale Friday, August 22<sup>nd</sup>, 10 am at [www.dulinghall.com](http://www.dulinghall.com).
